Policy Title: Minor Age Membership Fee Structure

Description: This policy is to establish a transition in membership fees for minor aged officials.

Purpose/Rationale: This policy is to establish a system that makes it economical for new minor age officials to begin their officiating careers with BCFOA.

Applicability: This policy applies to all minor age officials identified by the Director, Member Services of their region.

Policy: BCFOA will establish scale system to gradually introduce BCFOA membership fees to minor officials.

Procedure(s):

Minor aged official is defined as an official at the start of the football season as being under the age of 19 years old.

Officials need to identify their age to the Director, Member Services for their region.

The Director, Member Services for each region will supply a list of officials that qualify for this policy. This shall be done before the end of the football season.

Officials who work 10 or less games will pay no membership fee; officials who work 11 to 20 games will pay 50% of the membership fee; officials who work 21 or more game will pay the full fee.

Should an official fail to be identified as being a minor age official, the Director, Member Services will notify the Treasurer as soon as possible to correct any errors or omissions.
